Back in 2020, when travelling was not easy due to global conditions, and in order to respond to an increasing request for learning Latin and Greek with the methods used in our Academy, we replaced our renowned summer courses with an equally *intensive on-line program* that reproduced a **daily full-immersion** from home.

The success of this experiment, as well as the enthusiastic feedback of many participants, encouraged us to propose the *whole-year on-line courses*, that consists on a **more extended program** paced in such a way that it **easily adapts to the daily schedule** of students of different ages all around the world.

Moreover, since we are convinced that the humanities should be cultivated through direct contact and communication, we created the *Otia Tusculana* and allowed the participants of the on-line program to meet on the campus of our Academy, and to **culminate their instruction with a shared experience of the Classical languages** and the cultural treasures that they hold.

Now, after refining our on-line methodologies, and being finally able to restart our on-campus summer lessons, we have decided to arrange all these courses in a **unified program** that **joins distance learning and on-campus lessons** systematically, and offers the possibility to combine a variety of options in the way that better suits the necessities of each student.

We hope that this formula will prove useful for new students eager to learn with our unique methods, and that will give to our old friends an opportunity to keep experiencing the Classical humanities with the approach that we always try to foster at the *Vivarium novum*.

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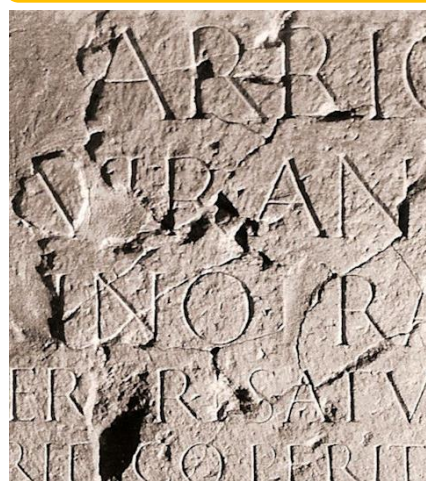

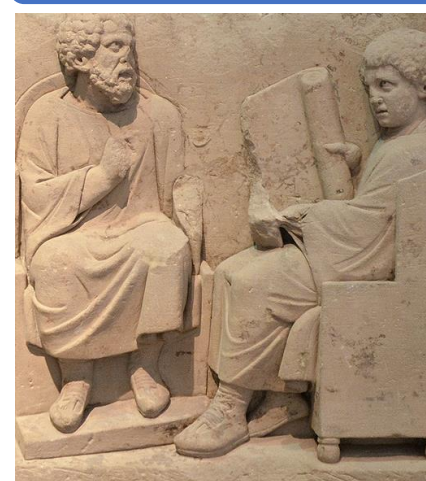
